## ROLES of the PRESIDENT :

- 1 The president has the power over the creation of laws, by passing or vetoing legislation.
- 2 The president protects the country by commanding the armed forces.
- 3 The president can request the cabinet to give a written opinion on a situation.
- 4 Another role of the president is to convene or adjourn congress.
- 5 The president also has the power to grant reprieves and pardons.
- 6 The president handles foreign affairs by making treaties which must be ratified by 2/3s of the Senate.
- 7 The president makes for-reign by working with and receiving ambassadors.
